SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES.

4.1 Description of first aid measures.

Due to the composition and type of the substances present in the product, no particular warnings are necessary.

Inhalation.

Take the victim into open air; keep them warm and calm. If breathing is irregular or stops, perform artificial respiration. Do not administer anything orally. If unconscious, place them in a suitable position and seek medical assistance.

Eye contact.

If wearing contact lenses, remove them. Wash eyes with plenty of clean and cool water for at least 10 minutes while pulling eyelids up, and seek medical assistance.

Skin contact.

Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin vigorously with water and soap or a suitable skin cleaner. **NEVER** use solvents or thinners.

SECTION 5: FIREFIGHTING MEASURES.

Recommended extinguishing methods.

7.1 Precautions for safe handling.

Packages larger than 20 liters, must be transferred under appropriate conditions with an automatic pump that spills directly from the drum to the application system. In the application area, smoking, eating, and drinking must be prohibited.
